As of March 30, 2020, the State of Connecticut is reporting one (1) laboratory-confirmed case of COVID-19 in the Town of Preston. This person is between 30 and 40 years old, has not been hospitalized and has not been in a long-term care facility. We have been expecting for some time that a Preston resident would become infected with COVID-19, so hopefully this does not come as a surprise. Town officials, first responders and Uncas Health District staff have been working closely to plan and prepare for the presence of COVID-19. Residents should continue to protect themselves by practicing social distancing, washing hands and all other precautionary measures recommended by the CDC, Uncas Health District and our Governor's Executive Orders.
