

LEGAL NOTICE

TOWN OF PRESTON

FILINGS FOR 10/1/2020 GRAND LIST

PERSONAL PROPERTY: Personal Property declarations are being mailed to all businesses and owners of tangible property on the October 1st 2020 Grand List. New businesses should request forms from the Assessor. All owners of tangible personal property are required, by Connecticut General Statutes, to file with the Assessor annually, during the month of October, a listing of such tangible personal property. All unregistered motor vehicles, vehicles registered out-of-state and garaged in Preston, campers and all unregistered trailers must be declared.

FAILURE TO FILE: Section 12-42 of the Connecticut General Statutes requires the Assessor to file a listing for those who fail to file or file late and add a 25% penalty to the listing. The deadline to file is November 1, 2020.

NOTICE TO VETERANS: Veterans who have not yet filed their discharge papers with the Town Clerk are reminded that the deadline to file is September 30, 2020 to be eligible for an exemption on the 2020 Grand List. The original or a certified copy of the Honorable Discharge (DD214), or similar, must be filed with the Town Clerk's office prior to October 1, 2020. Veterans of any war period, so declared in Section 12-81, Subsection 19 of the Connecticut General Statutes, having received an Honorable Discharge, or still serving on active duty, are eligible for the veteran's exemption.

NOTICE TO TOTALLY DISABLED PERSONS: Disabled persons who have not filed their SSA Award Letter with the Assessor are reminded to file their proof of disability prior to October 1, 2020.

NOTICE TO BLIND PERSONS: Blind persons who have not filed their Certification of Blindness from the State of Connecticut Board of Education and Services for the Blind with the Assessor are reminded to file their proof of blindness prior to October 1, 2020.

NOTICE TO PA 490 APPLICANTS: Property owners wishing to file an application claiming their land as farm and/or forestry should file an application, with the Assessor's office, between September 1 and prior to October 1, 2020.
