Driveway/Highway Permit

Sec. 1. An ordinance regulating building of approaches to any town road or street of the Town of Preston adopted June 3, 1965 in hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Before building an approach to any town road or highway, a permit must be obtained from the First Selectman or his agent. This permit will be valid for one year from the date of issuance time all work necessary shall be completed.

In determining whether a permit shall be issued, the First Selectman shall give due consideration of the effect of the proposed approach upon the public safety, and to drainage needs.

Sec. 3. All necessary drainage pipes, culverts, headwalls and/or catch basins and/or ditches must be installed where deemed necessary by the First Selectman or his agent.

The paving from the edge of the traveled roadway to the property line shall consist of bituminous concrete compacted to a depth of at least two (2) inches unless varies with the written permission of the First Selectman.

Sec. 4. The holder of this permit shall be responsible for any damage done to the town highway in the building of the approach. An applicant shall deposit with the Town Treasurer, security in the form of a bond with sufficient surety or cash, in such amount as may be required by the First Selectman sufficient to cover the completion of the approach, including work required to repair the town highway.

Sec. 5. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be a fine not to exceed \$100.00.
