



Textile Recycling Program

The Town is initiating a new textile collection and recycling program! A textile recycling program removes useable clothing and other textiles from the waste stream so they can be recycled and repurposed. Currently, clothing and textiles make up nearly 10% of all solid waste. Additionally, nearly 85% of clothing and textiles that are thrown away are reusable or recyclable. The Town has partnered through SCRRRA with Apparel Impact, a Veteran and Family-owned company that focuses on supporting and giving back to communities throughout the country. The goal of this partnership is to reduce the Town's volume of municipal solid waste which lessens costs at the transfer station, helps the environment while also supporting families in need and non-profit organizations throughout the United States.

Collection bins have been placed at the Town Hall and Transfer Station. Textiles aren't limited to just clothing but include bedding, footwear, backpacks, pocketbooks, curtains, towels, and stuffed animals among other items. Please see the full list below of items that can be placed in these bins. The Town urges residents to take advantage of this program by donating their used clothing and textiles instead of disposing of them in the regular trash. This is a win for all!
