



Public Information Meeting on the Rehabilitation Mohegan Pequot Bridge in Montville and Preston

9/30/2024

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) will conduct a hybrid public information meeting concerning the rehabilitation of the Mohegan-Pequot Bridge in Montville and Preston on **Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 7:00 pm. The meeting will take place at the Montville Public Safety Building located at 911 Norwich-New London Turnpike, Uncasville, CT 06382. The meeting will also take place on Zoom.**

This hybrid public information meeting is being held to provide the public and local community the opportunity to offer comments or ask questions regarding the proposed project. A question and answer (Q&A) session will immediately follow the presentation, which will be recorded. “This project will address existing bridge deterioration and extend the service life for another 20 years or more,” said **Connecticut Department of Transportation Project Manager James Barrows II**. “We encourage the public to attend this meeting to share their feedback with the CTDOT project team to incorporate into the design.”

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated with this project.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2028. The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$32.8 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
