The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project will support the Southeast Area Transit District (SEAT)'s transition to a fully electric transit system by expanding the current facility for the operation and maintenance of an all-electric fleet. The project includes the design and construction of a new indoor charging and storage area for electric buses and paratransit vehicles, and the construction of solar panels as a power source for the facility.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2027 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s) The estimated cost is \$50 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds
