

Poquetanuck Cove Floating Trail

The Town of Preston Parks, Recreation, & Youth Services Department is submitting a Community Connectivity Grant administered through the Connecticut Department of Transportation. The proposed project, titled Poquetanuck Cove Floating Trail will be a 900' long out & back floating boardwalk that will allow users to view Poquetanuck Cove from a perspective that has only been accessible to those in a water craft. The boardwalk will be ADA compliant and will be accessible to all ages and abilities.

Access to the boardwalk will be from the newly constructed Rt. 2A sidewalk. A switchback ramp will bring users down to water level where users can then enjoy a leisurely stroll on the boardwalk. The approximate location of the switchback ramp is across the street from 196 Rt. 2A. If awarded, the earliest construction would begin in the Summer of 2026 however due to several factors construction may not begin until 2027.
