[Sustainable CT](#) is a free, voluntary certification program that supports and recognizes thriving and resilient Connecticut municipalities. An independently funded, grassroots, municipal effort, the program provides a comprehensive menu of sustainability best practices, technical assistance, and funding to implement them, and recognition of town accomplishments through certification, with options for Bronze, Silver, and Gold levels. Sustainable CT is designed to support all Connecticut municipalities, regardless of size, geography, or resources, and empowers municipalities to create high collective impact for current and future residents.

A [resolution](#) was passed by the BOS that indicates the Town's intent to participate and a Sustainability Team was established to help identify projects, follow through with their completion and submit documentation to Sustainable CT in order to become certified.
