



New Gas Cylinder Recycling Program

Preston residents may now recycle gas cylinders at the Preston Transfer Station free of charge!

We are pleased to announce the Town of Preston is now a part of a cylinder collection program through [The Cylinder Collective \(TCC\)](#), a nonprofit organization designed to implement and operate recycling programs for pressurized cylinders.



Why recycle gas cylinders? Recycling residential gas cylinders is good for the environment. In addition, it is important to ensure responsible management of residential gas cylinders when their usefulness is completed. Once collected at the Preston Transfer Station, aggregated gas cylinders are sent for processing. Metal processed from the cylinders can be recycled into other products. In some cases, the remaining gas can also be recovered.

- Punctured cylinders
- Fire extinguishers
- Candle or cigarette lighters
- Absolutely No Vapes or Nitrous Oxide Cylinders**
